YFFC ran free daily programs for the youth of Columbus all summer long – from cooking class to art class, stress & anger management class, Warrior Wednesday nerf wars, GAPS and free guitar lessons.

This new school year looks different – we are not allowed to run lunch groups or be in the schools, yet... **BUT** that isn't stopping us from meeting the kids where they are at. We have kicked off all our after-school and night Club programs and have extended our hours M-TH until 9pm so we can run small groups at night after our Club programs end. This gives the teens who participate in sports and other activities more time and options to get together with a small group at YFFC.

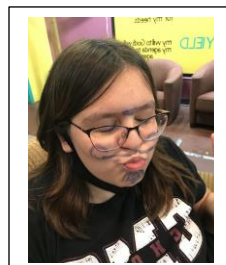
